Pupils needed for filming of annual health check video for Derbyshire Healthcare

The Learning Disability Team in Derby are putting together a short film about the LD annual health check which everyone with a LD can attend from the age of 14 years old at their GP surgery. Their aim is to raise awareness within the younger age group, inform them about the health check, what is involved etc and to also increase attendance. They want to ensure that they and their families and carers know about the LD annual health check, making it a positive experience and reducing anxiety around attending GP appointments. Because people with a LD can't always recognise their own health needs, the annual health check is a proactive assessment which can detect conditions/illness at an early stage which can then be treated before becoming too serious and life threatening.

They are looking for two pupils from our school who may like to take part in the filming of a short video to represent this younger age group (preferably 14 years and above), to promote the LD annual health checks. The filming will probably be over a couple of days within Derby city, however we are also suggesting for the pupils to be filmed within their own familiar surroundings if this is what they would prefer.

They are hoping to film around the beginning to the end of July, preferably completion before the 23rd July.
