Message from the Head Teacher

Dear Parent/Carers

Following on from a CCTV Consultation that was sent out to parents via the weekly bulletin in June 2022 I can confirm that we have received no objections to extending the CCTV coverage in order that we can continue to meet our safeguarding and site security goals at Brackenfield SEND School. There were a couple of questions raised to which are answered below:

1. Will the 'footage' be saved and for how long?

Footage is retained on the CCTV system for 21 days and is then overwritten.

2. Is there any back-up system?

We do not backup the CCTV Footage. Where we save footage for an investigation this is only be retained as long as is necessary for the purposes of discharging the investigation for which it was required.

We will be proceeding with the CCTV expansion over the coming months/weeks and will send you out an update on when this will happen.
