#### Scarlet Fever Communication from UKHSA

Whilst we have no confirmed cases in school there is a high level of related illnesses. Please see your child's GP if they are unwell with any of the listed symptoms.

The first symptoms of scarlet fever often include a sore throat, headache, fever, nausea and vomiting.

After after 12 to 48 hours the characteristic fine red rash develops (if you touch it, it feels like sandpaper). Typically, it first appears on the chest and stomach, rapidly spreading to other parts of the body. On more darkly-pigmented skin, the rash may be harder to spot, although the 'sandpaper' feel should be present

Further symptoms include:

- fever over 38.3º C (101º F) or higher is common
- white coating on the tongue which peels a few days later, leaving the tongue looking red and swollen (known as 'strawberry tongue')
- swollen glands in the neck
- feeling tired and unwell
- flushed red face, but pale around the mouth. The flushed face may appear more 'sunburnt' on darker skin
- peeling skin on the fingertips, toes and groin area, as the rash fades

It usually takes 2 to 5 days from infection before the first symptoms appear. However, the incubation period may be as short as 1 day and as long as 7 days. Scarlet fever usually clears up after a week, but it is advisable to visit your GP to get a full diagnosis and proper treatment.

#### **Available Courses**

As part of the school we also have the East Midlands SEND Training Hub where we run courses for staff within school and from outside of school. Two courses we have coming up maybe of interest to parents and you would be welcome to book onto these. There is a cost involved to these courses as they are run by outside professionals. This one-day workshop is led by a senior Occupational Therapist at Children's Sensory Therapy who has vast expertise and experience in Sensory Processing Disorder and Sensory Integration. Its aim is to increase understanding of Sensory Processing Disorder and offer practical guidance, ideas and strategies to support children who may struggle with sensory

processing. Understanding a child's challenges with sensory processing and how the school can support, can make a big difference to a child's learning experience as well as their continued growth and development.

This course would be ideal for parents of children who have sensory processing disorders.
