





Have a great break over the holidays, don't forget to send in photos of your children's holiday activities to class email boxes so that staff can talk about these with the children in September.



Dear Parents and Carers,

As stated in the May Parent and Carer Newsletter, the Home to School Travel Service was aiming to let all parents and carers know the travel arrangements for their child by the end of the summer term. Unfortunately, and due to unforeseen circumstances, the Home to School Travel Service is not in a position to confirm your child's transport arrangements by this deadline.

Please note: All transport contracts are being retendered. Therefore, your child is very likely to be traveling with a different operator from September; this means a different vehicle, with a different driver and passenger assistant (where required).

The team are working hard to secure your child's travel arrangements and will be contacting you during the summer holidays to confirm the arrangements and to arrange meet and greet visits once contracts have been awarded.






FREE summer food support vouchers for families who receive benefit related free school meals

As part of the Household Support Scheme, Derbyshire County Council are distributing oneoff grocery vouchers to families eligible for benefit related free school meals. A £50 grocery voucher will be provided to every eligible child.

The Council intends to start to distribute the vouchers to families from Friday 8 July and expect the process to be completed by Wednesday 13 July 2022.

How will the vouchers be provided to parents?




The majority of vouchers will be sent out by email with a smaller number sent via text.

Emails will be sent out by the Council's voucher provider, Huggg LTD and will be sent from the address: <u>hello@huggg.me</u>


On occasion emails from Hugggs can be directed into a recipient's junk mail folder so please check your junk if you cannot see the voucher in your inbox.

The emails will look like this and will have a link to download the voucher:

Vouchers sent by text will be sent from the Council's 'email to text' system and will show as being sent from Derbyshire County Council. The text messages will include a link to download the voucher from the Hugggs website.

How can parents who are struggling financially apply for further financial support from the Household Support Fund?

Information about how parents can apply for a grant from the Household Support Fund is available on the Council's website at: <u>www.derbyshire.gov.uk/householdsupportfund</u>.

Grant applications via this route are taken over the phone and, due to very high demand, callers may have to wait a considerable amount of time to get through or to receive a call back.

Families **do not** have to be eligible for benefit related free school meals to access a Household Support Fund grant, as the Council recognises there may be families who are not eligible but who may be struggling financially due to being on a low income. More information about eligibility is available on the website.

KIDS EAT FOR FREE OR LESS DURING SUMMER 2022

MORRISONS

Spend £4.99 to get a free kids meal after 3pm daily, normally all day during half term.

ASDA CAFE

Kids eat for £1 every day with NO need for a paying adult from 25th July - 4th Sept, 2022.

DUNELM

One free mini main, two snacks and a drink for every £4 spent in the instore cafe.

YO! Kids eat free from 3pm-5:30pm Mon-Thurs for every £10 spent on food.

BEEFEATER & BREWERS FAYRE

Free breakfast for two children under 16 with every paying adult.

HUNGRY HORSE

Free kids breakfast with an adults breakfast from 9am-12pm daily.

IKEA

Get TWO kids hot meals, fruit, drink and jelly for £5 in their Swedish restaurants (subject to availability).

BELLA ITALIA

Kids eat for £1 with each adult meal from 4-6pm on Mon-Thurs.

DOBBIES

Kids eat free with an adult main meal.

TABLE TABLE

Two children under 16 get a free breakfast with one paying adult every day.

CAFE ROUGE


Kids eat for £1 with an adult meal excluding Saturday.


The holiday clubs are running across the county from Monday 25th July – Friday 2nd September, with provision in every district/borough.
