

Holidays in Term time:

Following several requests from parents to take their child out of school to go away on holiday we wish to clarify that the law requires parents to ensure their child's regular attendance at school and normally we would not expect you to take your child out of school for a holiday. There is no automatic right to a holiday in term time and it is expected that you use the 175 of non-school days in each year for holidays, cultural experiences and family time.

When can my child miss school?

It is only acceptable for your child to miss school if:

they are too ill to attend

you have got advance permission from the school

If you are thinking about taking a holiday in term-time, then you must put this request in writing to the Headteacher (Mrs Turner). All holidays will be unauthorised unless there are exceptional circumstances. If your holiday is unauthorised and you choose to not send your child to school, you may be fined.

What will the fine be?

Your local council can issue a fine to each parent. This is £60 which rises to £120 if you do not pay within 21 days. If you do not pay the fine after 28 days you may be prosecuted for your child's absence from school. A prosecution could result in a fine of up to £2500, a community order or a jail sentence up to 3 months. The court will also give you a Parenting Order.

Important recall of Emerade 300 and 500 microgram adrenaline auto-injector pens (AAIs): If you or your child carries the Emerade brand of AAI, you should immediately contact your GP to get 2 replacement pens of a different brand - either EpiPen or Jext.

You should only return your Emerade pens to your local pharmacy once you have received your replacement AAIs.
