Message from the Headteacher:

Dear parent/carers,

As you will be aware from previous communication, we were due to have new Portacabins installed on site over the summer break. These buildings are currently being used by a Derbyshire primary school on a temporary basis. Due to issues with their new buildings, they are unable to move out of the Portacabins, to enable them to be moved on to our school site. As a result, 2 classes are housed at the Outlook Centre on Briar Gate. All parents of pupils who are affected have been made aware.

We hope this will only be for a short period of time but we will keep you updated over the coming weeks.
