#### **Attendance**

Keep up good attendance, it is so beneficial for your child. If you notice your child becomes more tired towards the end of the week we are able to offer them extra support, this would enable them to get something out of the day and keep routines going. It gives you some time for yourself too.

#### Keep your child protected, are their vaccinations up to date?

You may be aware from media coverage that there has been a nationwide decline in the number of children who are fully vaccinated against infectious illnesses such as measles.

Vaccination is a safe and effective way to protect your child against certain diseases, including measles, mumps, whooping cough, polio and meningitis. Without the immunity provided by a vaccination, your child is more likely to catch the disease and become seriously ill. This also puts other children and vulnerable adults at higher risk, as the disease can spread more easily when vaccination levels are lower.

Childhood vaccinations are offered free of charge by the NHS. We encourage you to make sure your child has received all the appropriate vaccinations for their age.

If you're not sure if your child has had all their routine vaccinations, check their personal health record (Red Book) or contact your GP surgery, which will have up-to-date records.

To protect your child and our staff from infectious illnesses, the school follows government and NHS guidance on when pupils should be kept off school and when they shouldn't. Please click here to read through the NHS Guidance: <u>Is my</u> child too ill for school? - NHS
