Attendance and Safeguarding

Did you know about the Pharmacy First Service?

Your local pharmacy offers a service called **Pharmacy First**, provided by the NHS. This convenient service allows both children and adults to access quick healthcare advice without the need to wait for a GP appointment. By walking into a participating pharmacy, you can request a consultation with a pharmacist in a private consultation room. Additionally, some pharmacies offer remote consultations via video.

The **Pharmacy First** service supports the following conditions:

- Earache (ages 1-17 years)
- Impetigo (ages 1 year and over)
- Infected insect bites (ages 1 year and over)
- Sore throats (ages 5 years and over)
- Shingles (age 18 years and over)
- Sinusitis (age 12 years and over)
- Urinary tract infections (UTIs) in women (ages 16 to 64 years)

The pharmacist will provide expert advice and, if clinically necessary, prescribe medication to treat the condition. This service can be especially helpful for parents and carers who are experiencing difficulties booking GP appointments for the conditions listed above.

Across school we use the British Sign Language alphabet for names. It is useful to learn this to support pupils to fingerspell as this is used by the deaf community. <u>Fingerspelling Alphabet Charts - Access BSL</u>. There is also a Deaf Blind manual alphabet which you can look at on this website which is similar but adapted for pupils who are both blind and deaf.


